

Evangelical Churches in Belarus: History and Modernity, vol. 3

by various Belarusian scholars, in Belarusian

Leonid Mikhovich, president of Minsk Theological Seminary, and Belarusian field director for TCM, along with scholars from regarded schools and research establishments in Belarus and Poland, have published their third collection of conference papers: *Evangelical Churches in Belarus: History and Modernity, Volume 3*. The Orthodox and Catholic churches often ostracize the minority (5%) Bible believing churches. Leonid hopes these scholarly studies will help turn this around.

LATM helped publish Volumes 1 (2014) and 2 (2016). This third collection addresses scientific issues as well as promotes interest in the Evangelical Church in Belarus in the academic world, and affirms the church in Belarusian society.

Its publication is especially timely for academic libraries, universities, colleges, and churches as Belarus celebrates the 500th Anniversary of the Belarusian Bible. Belarusians got the Bible in 1517, in a language that common citizens would understand. It was the eighth printed translation of the Holy Scriptures in the world, and the second among Slavic peoples.
